Full Job Description

Openings: Full Time/Part Time Paramedics.

The Paramedic job function is to transport sick and injured persons by ambulance in a manner conducive to their safety and comfort and to administer Basic Life Support & Advanced Life Support care and treatment within the limits defined by State Protocol and Medical Director's guidance:

- Must possess a valid Paramedic 2022 license issued by NREMT
- Must be able to affiliate as a Paramedic 2022 in the State of Idaho
- Current Health Care Provider CPR Card
- Current ACLS & PALS Cards
- Valid Driver License & clean driving record
- Must be able to pass a pre-employment drug screening & criminal background check
- Must be able to interact well with patients, relatives, and fellow workers

Flexible scheduling: PACT EMS allows flexibility in scheduling. In general, PACT EMS utilizes both 48 and 24-hour shift schedules.

Benefits: Currently PACT EMS offers Direct Primary Care membership, paid vacation and paid sick.

Compensation: Pay periods are bi-weekly. Advances are on a case-by-case basis.

Training: All members of PACT EMS are provided training in house at no charge. An allowance of \$600.00 will be given for the employee to take the Critical Care class and who will dedicate themselves to one year of employment.
